PILOT COVE FOREST LODGING OPENS FOR 2017 TRAVELERS

Pilot Cove welcomes visitors to Transylvania County and Western North Carolina. Directly bordering Pisgah National Forest, the development is comprised of 10 modern cabins, each appointed with a full kitchen, washer/dryer, cable and free wifi. The custom-designed units range in size from studio, one bedroom, and two bedrooms, each with a private deck allowing guests to interact with the natural wooded surroundings. Local contractors, artists, and tradesmen were commissioned for the project, supporting the community's vision for locally grown, sustainable tourism.

The wooded property includes a flow trail system open to both mountain bikers and hikers who are staying on site. Pilot Cove's location at the Hwy 276 entrance to Pisgah National Forest allows for ride in ride out access for guests who wish to access the trails, greenway, or road cycling. Guests can enjoy picnic areas with grills and campfire rings.

Future plans for the development include an amphitheater with stage to host concerts, weddings, and other events, as well as a campground and additional cabins for rent.
